

**AGREEMENT
REGARDING
MUTUAL CERTIFICATION**

Japan Information-Technology Engineers Examination Center (hereinafter "JITEC"), an integral part of Information-technology Promotion Agency, Japan (hereinafter "IPA"), an Independent Administrative Agency existing under the laws of Japan, and National Information Technology Park (hereinafter "NITP"), a not for profit government organization under the jurisdiction of Information and Communication Technology Authority (ICTA) of the Government of Mongolia, existing under the laws of Mongolia, hereby conclude this Agreement regarding the implementation of mutual certification concerning the Information Technology Engineers' Skill Standards of JITEC/IPA (hereinafter the "JITEC Skill Standards", attached as Appendix A hereto), and the Information Technology Engineers' Skill Standards established by NITP (hereinafter the "NITP Skill Standards", attached as Appendix B hereto), under the following terms and conditions.

Article 1. Purpose of Mutual Certification

The purpose of this Agreement is to encourage the growth of business activities related to information technology and to promote the mobility of IT personnel between Japan and Mongolia by mutually certifying that the scope of knowledge, skills and technology contained in JITEC Skill Standards and NITP Skill Standards are equivalent.

Article 2. Contents of Mutual Certification

The scope of knowledge, skills and technology in the Skill Standards provided by JITEC and the Skill Standards provided by NITP respectively, as shown below, are certified as being equivalent.

Article 3. Follow-up

1. Both JITEC and NITP shall notify the other party promptly when either the JITEC Skill Standards or the NITP Skill Standards are changed, unless the changes are minor and the mutually certified scope of knowledge, skills and technology is unchanged.
2. When either JITEC or NITP receives a notice from the other party concerning changes in their respective Skill Standards, the notified party shall endeavor to maintain the coverage of such changed Standards in its own Skill Standards by taking the measures prescribed in the following paragraph.
3. Measures to be taken when changes are made in the JITEC Skill Standards or the NITP Skill Standards:
 - (a) JITEC or NITP shall inform the other party of changes made to the Skill Standards.
 - (b) The party receiving the information shall consider the necessity of making changes to their Skill Standards it provides, and when it deems that changes are necessary, it shall consider the specific changes to be made and the method to be used (hereinafter the "Corresponding Measures").
 - (c) JITEC or NITP shall inform the other party of such Corresponding Measures promptly as soon as the consideration of the Corresponding Measures is finished.
 - (d) When JITEC or NITP receives notification of the Corresponding Measures relating to its own changes from the other party, it shall review such Corresponding Measures and make recommendations as necessary.
 - (e) JITEC or NITP shall, when it receives the recommendation stated in the preceding subparagraph, comply with the same.

Article 4. Cancellation of Mutual Certification

JITEC or NITP may cancel this Agreement on the occurrence of any of the following:

- 1) When the other party conducts any act that is in violation of the purpose of the mutual certification,
- 2) When the other party does not observe any of the provisions prescribed in Article 3,

- b) When a party notifies the other party with its intent to cancel the mutual certification.

Article 5. Consultation and Mutual Agreement

This Agreement may be amended based on consultation and any matters not stipulated herein shall be determined and agreed upon through mutual discussions between the two parties.

Article 6. Maintaining Equivalence of Levels Between the Japan Information Technology Engineers Examination and the Mongolia Information Technology Engineers Examination

The Japan Information Technology Engineers Examination based on "The Promotion of Information Processing Act" and formulated in accordance with the JITEC Skill Standards prescribed in Article 2 is implemented by JITEC. The Mongolia Information Technology Engineers Examination endorsed by the Mongolian government authority and formulated in accordance with the NITP Skill Standards prescribed in the same Article will be implemented by NITP. Both JITEC and NITP must endeavor to ensure that the scopes of questions, difficulty levels of questions and acceptable levels of the two are equivalent.

Article 7. Appendix


